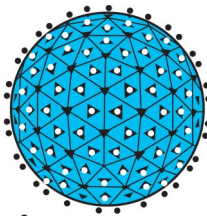

The law does not allow us to issue tax receipts for 2017 for anything received after December 31, 2017, even though it may be dated 2017. The only exception would be if we were to receive money in the mail postmarked on or before December 31, 2017. (Tax receipts will be sent out for individual checks of \$250 or more by January 31, 2018.) You may also access your giving statement at any time through our online database.
