2021 tax return

Just a reminder that all checks given to the church which you want to count on your 2021 tax return must be in the office or contribution on or before December 31, 2021. The law does not allow us to issue tax receipts for 2021 for anything received after December 31, 2021, even though it may be dated 2021. The only exception would be if we were to receive money in the mail postmarked on or before December 31, 2021. (Tax receipts will be sent out for individual checks of \$250 or more by January 31, 2022.) You may also access your giving statement at any time through our online database (or call the office for a copy).
