# **Faith Village 2023 Tax Return Information**

Just a reminder that all checks given to the church that you want to count on your 2023 tax return must be in the office or contribution on or before December 31, 2023. The law does not allow us to issue tax receipts for 2023 for anything received after December 31, 2023, even though it may be dated 2023. The only exception would be if we were to receive money in the mail postmarked on or before December 31, 2023. (Tax receipts will be sent out for individual checks of \$250 or more by **January 31, 2024.**)

You may also access your giving statement at any time through our online database (or call the office for a copy).

#### **HomeMission 2023 Tax Return Information**

The law does not allow us to issue tax letters for 2023 for anything received after this date, even though it may be dated before. Tax letters will be sent out by Jan 31, 2024.
